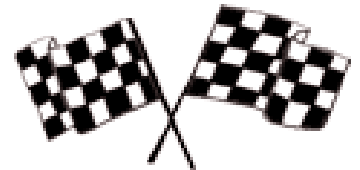

2011 Season Racing Plan: In 2011, we will be racing on a weekly basis at Luxemburg Speedway on Friday evenings. We will also run a few specials throughout the year as well as an occasional appearance at Thunderhill Speedway on Saturday Evenings, 141 Speedway, and Seymour Speedway on Sunday Evenings. We are also planning to go to the Frost buster's event in Iowa at the beginning of April. We are hoping to make a few appearances in Iowa this year.

Car Information: In 2010, we completely updated the car to the current rules. We made all necessary changes to keep it safe and legal. It was stripped down to the roll cage and repainted from bottom up. The picture to the right is the paint job that I will have for the 2011 race season. It will be getting lettered within a month or two so it is ready for the race in Iowa.
